Organ said it is up to the districts/colleges to justify the families to the auditors. Wayne will send the table out to department chairs for feedback. Council reviewed the Principles of Families document that came from the State Chancellor's office. They will follow up with question at the meeting scheduled on February 5 with Mehdizadeh. Organ expressed concern we are experimenting on our students. He said in performing arts, music and PE, students have been able to progress and compete on national levels but this could limit their potential.
