VPEI Joe Gorga and College President Monica Chahal joined the senate to provide updates. DEDE Coordinator Rayshell Clapper shared plans to develop a course and support resources on Regular and Substantive Interaction (RSI). Council shared feedback they had heard at Department/Division meetings regarding faculty concerns and support needed for AI. Council reviewed the current draft of Business Procedure 10.06 - Acceptable Technology Use. Senate discussed and approved a proposed election process and timelines for the Adjunct Representation positions.

Liu reported student survey results indicating that they remain confused as to what AI acceptable use guidelines are in their classes. Liu shared a PPTX presentation outlining a three-stage model. Link to presentation is here. Emma shared the DRAFT Responsible Technology & AI Use at 4CD: A Guide to Data, Privacy, Policy, and Practice document. Next steps: Identify leads at each college for AI-resource development. AI student focus groups feedback will be analyzed. Data guide for 4CD being developed and will be overseen by the district AI Task team. Need a clear picture about what we want to achieve. We will never be able to catch up with AI technology, so it comes down to what we want our faculty and students to know about the tools available.
