Governing Board Meeting of April 10, 2024

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, April 10, 2024, beginning at 4:00 p.m. where they recognized newly tenured faculty and the Classified Professional of the Year at a reception, which was then followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

Highlights are listed below.

Special Reports

The Governing Board heard a special report concerning the Development of the 2024-25 4CD Budget. The presentation provided an overview of the current budget climate in Sacramento and potential impacts on 4CD, along with an outline of steps being currently undertaken to help mitigate any fiscal challenges which may emerge.

Purchasing Agreements

The Governing Board approved several agreements, including:

- a new Contra Costa College agreement, which will allow nursing students to participate in clinical experiences; and
- several new Diablo Valley College agreements, including one which will provide training on the care of infants and children with prenatal substance exposure and another which will provide supervised oral health care experiences for dental students; and
- two new Districtwide agreements, including one to provide international student recruitment, marketing, consultation, advising, and application support and another which authorizes Santa Clara County to provide legal advisory services to 4CD.

Draft Facilities Master Plan

A presentation on the development of a Facilities Master Plan for each college, with an overview on the scope parameters, main goals, and desired outcomes of the planning process was summarized.

New Course Offerings

The Governing Board approved a variety of new course offerings across all three campuses in the fields of mathematics, kinesiology, and music, among others.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of retired DVC English professor Karl Staubach, retired DVC psychology and history professor Susan Goldstein and LMC English professor Michael Yeong.
