Governing Board Meeting of January 15, 2025

The Contra Costa Community College District (4CD) Governing Board conducted a regular meeting on Wednesday, January 15, 2025, beginning at 5:00 p.m., followed by closed session, and continuation of public session at 6:00 p.m.

Special Report - Early College Credit and K-12 Partnerships

A Districtwide team consisting of Associate Vice Chancellor, Educational Services Dr. Mandy Liang; Los Medanos College Dean, Office of Student Services Dave Belman, Contra Costa College (CCC) Interim Senior Academic/Student Services Manager Alex Stern; and Diablo Valley College Student Services Academic/Student Services Manager Sarah Peterson, summarized this report. It included information on 4CD's progress in Early College Credit programming through K-12 partnerships. Also highlighted were the DualEnroll.com pilot, the expansion of dual enrollment, the implementation of intentional outreach strategies, and the colleges' efforts to enhance student success.

State Legislative Report

The Governing Board heard a report from MGI Advocacy's Mark MacDonald regarding the Governor's latest budget proposal and they discussed Assembly Bills which could be addressed during their legislative visits in Sacramento at the end of this month.

2023-24 Audit Reports

The Governing Board accepted and approved the report presented by Eide Bailly LLP Partner Bill Rauch, CPA. 4CD, the Measure E Bond and the Retirement Trust Fund (OPEB) all received an "unmodified opinion," the highest rating that can be given.

Deletion of Obsolete Management/Supervisory Classification Descriptions

Human resources' review of 106 management and supervisory classification descriptions resulted in the Governing Board's approval to eliminate 34 classification descriptions. Many of these positions had been vacant for over 20 years and the some of the duties assigned to these positions are currently included within active positions.

The meeting was adjourned in memory of retired CCC Athletic Director Ed Greene.
