Highlights are listed below.

Student Panel on College Entry/Support Experience

Current and transferring students of various backgrounds shared their educational experiences at 4CD. These students spoke favorably about the programs and services offered. Beyond first-week orientations, they discussed ways in which students could be best supported throughout the academic year.

Governing Board Roles and Responsibilities

The Governing Board, with the aid of a facilitator, reviewed their respective roles and responsibilities. Board Policy 1010, <u>Code of Ethics of the Governing Board</u> was also discussed.
