### Districtwide Management Training

Cabinet received an update on the Districtwide fall training schedule for managers. Among the workshops to be offered are Crisis and Conflict Management: Legal and Contractual Issues; Harmonizing Perspectives: Increasing Cultural Competency, Team Building, and Embracing Diversity; and Updates on Collective Bargaining and New Laws Impacting Colleges.

### All College Day

College presidents shared highlights of their presentations for All College Day, and noted college anniversaries will also be celebrated at these events. The Chancellor will visit all colleges and speak to the continued theme of kindness, caring, and compassion.

### Artificial Intelligence (AI) Training

In September, one Cabinet meeting will be focused on AI and how it can be used in future strategic planning. Contra Costa College professor Chau Lin will facilitate this training.

### Enrollment Update

For fall 2024, enrollment Districtwide has increased by 6% from fall 2023. For summer 2024, an upward trend in enrollment was also noted. It increased by 16% from summer 2023.

### Business Procedure Review

Cabinet is reviewing updates which are necessary to align 4CD processes with best practices and requirements related to cybersecurity.
