Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

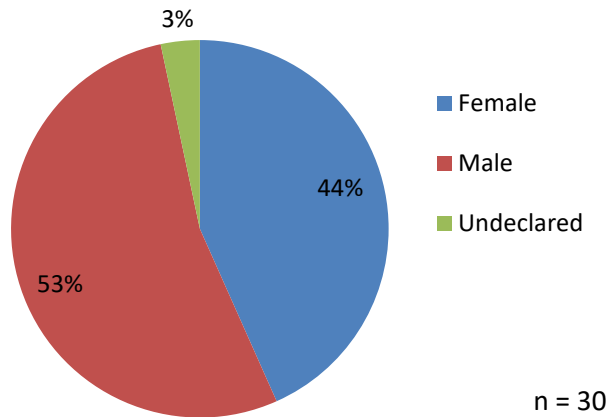


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

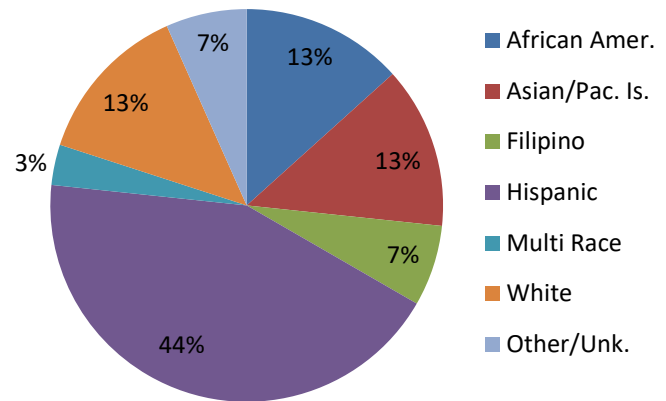

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

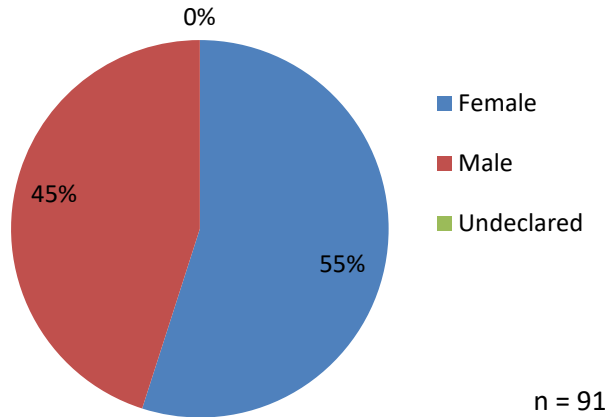


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

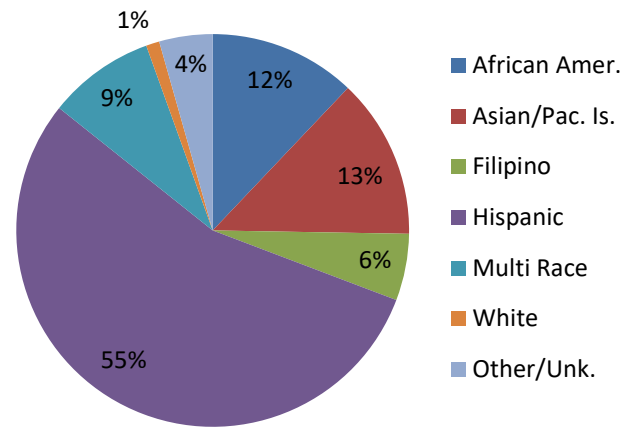

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

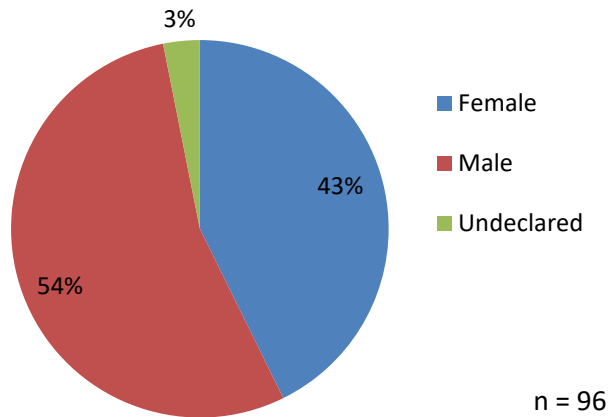


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

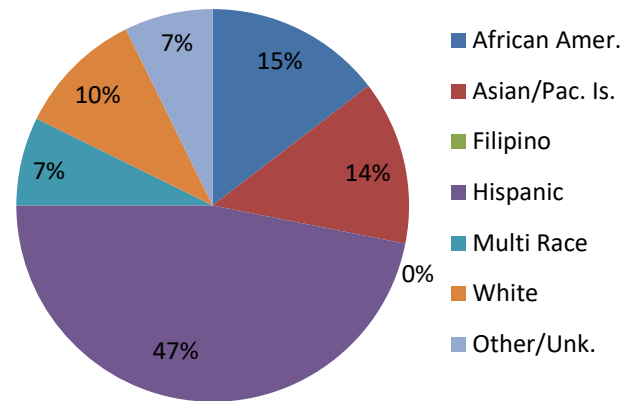

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

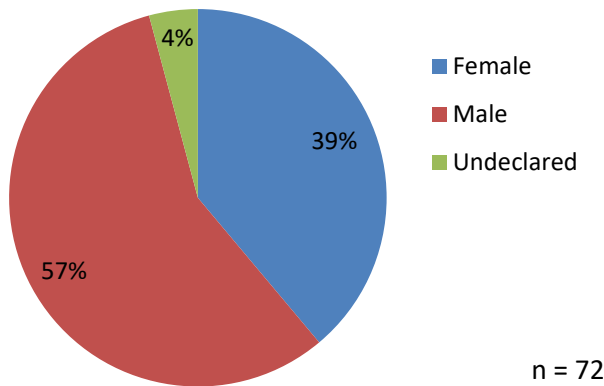


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

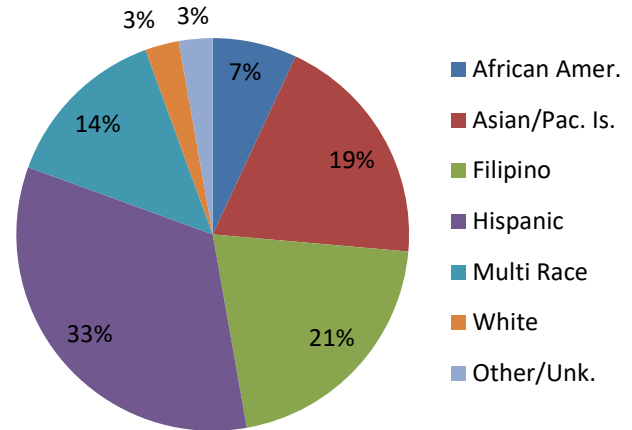

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

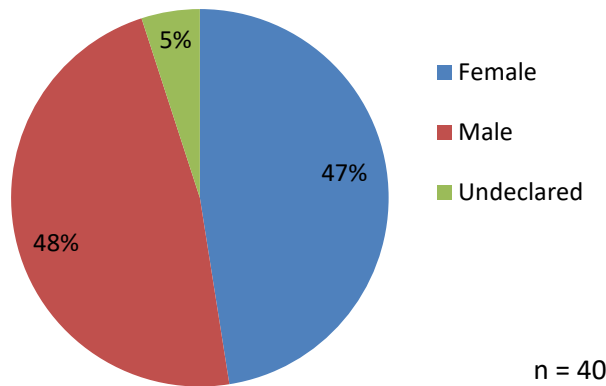


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

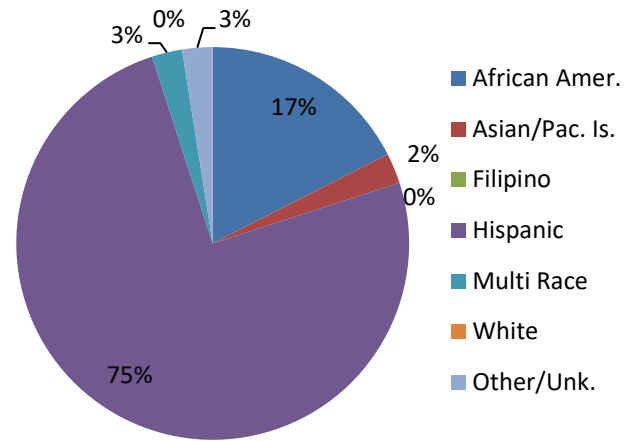

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

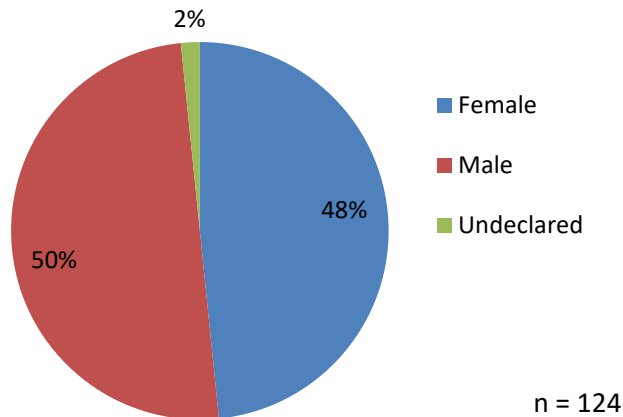


Figure 2: Racial/Ethnic Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

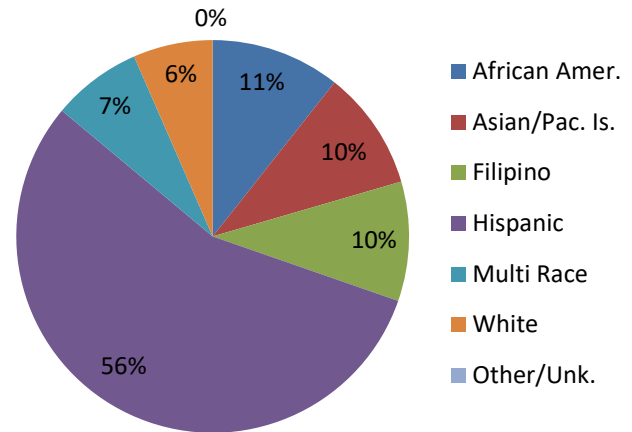

Figure 1: Gender Distribution of Students from Previous Year's Graduating Class Attending 4CD

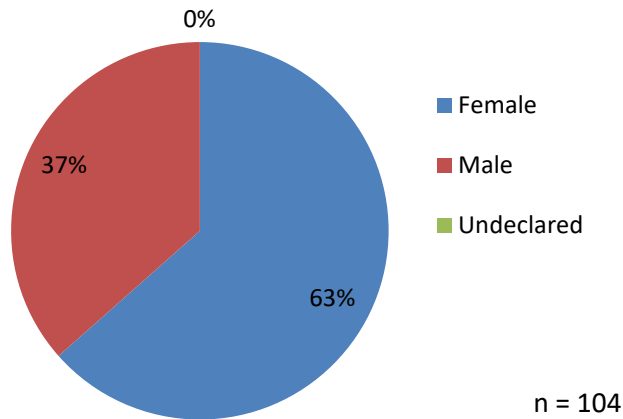


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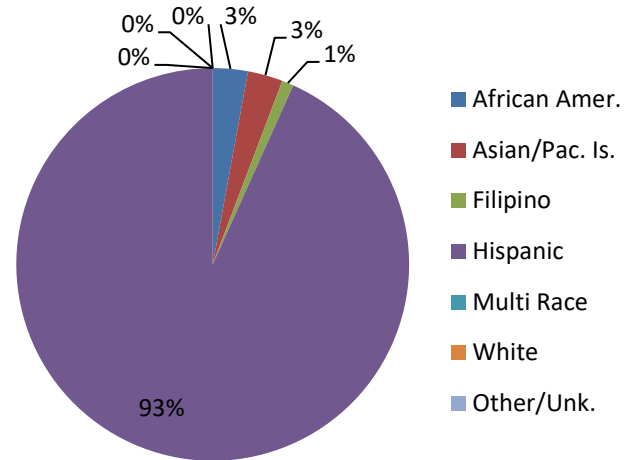
